Studio City Signs Occupational Safety and Health Charter

Macau, December 7, 2017 – Studio City, the Hollywood-inspired, cinematically themed resort, today signed the Macau Labour Affairs Bureau (DSAL)'s Occupational Safety and Health (OSH) Charter, a step further to strengthen its commitment to occupational safety. At the signing ceremony hosted at Studio City, Mr. David Sisk, Property President of Study City, signed the Charter on behalf of the establishment, under the witness of Mr. Wong Chi Hong, Director of the DSAL.

The OSH Charter program was established by the DSAL in 2002. It aims to promote safety in the workplace and to encourage commitment from Macau-based organizations to appropriately manage the occupational safety and health interests of employees.
