WORLD'S FIRST FIGURE-8 FERRIS WHEEL NEARS COMPLETION AT STUDIO CITY

Iconic Golden Reel Gets Ready to Roll

Macau – June 25, 2015 – Melco Crown Entertainment Limited (SEHK: 6883; Nasdaq: MPEL) ("Melco Crown Entertainment", "MCE" or the "Company"), a developer, owner and operator of casino gaming and entertainment resort facilities in Asia, proudly unveils the epic movie-inspired Golden Reel Ferris wheel as the iconic centerpiece attraction of the Company's soon to open US\$3.2billion Studio City complex in Macau.

Towering at 130 meters in Cotai, the Golden Reel is majestically located at the center-point between the resort's twin "Art Deco meets Gotham City" hotel towers, and will offer visitors a thrilling ride experience unique to Studio City.

As envisioned by Mr. Lawrence Ho, Co-Chairman and Chief Executive Officer of Melco Crown Entertainment, the Golden Reel was formed in traditional Hollywood blockbuster movie fashion when not one, but two flaming asteroids crashed through the building façade in tandem to create an almost perfect figure-8 form.

From the moment of arrival at the ride's level 3 entry lobby, guests are treated to a fantasy journey they will never forget. Blending the romance of the "Golden Age of Travel" with Melco Crown Entertainment's unprecedented ability to provide world-class entertainment experiences, the Golden Reel showcases the Company's commitment to leading the market with unique and industry redefining attractions.

Like the best-paced movie scripts, the next big "reveal" for guests is the Industrial Revolution themed loading platform, 23 floors above the ground floor. There are 17 "Steampunk"-themed cabins, each comfortably accommodating up to 10 people on the 15+ minute, jaw-dropping journey around the uniquely-shaped figure-8 track. The "never-been-done-before" attraction was designed and engineered by a world-class team lead by Liechtenstein-based Intamin Amusement Rides Int. Corp., world-renowned for highly-innovative amusement rides.

Every aspect of the Golden Reel is currently undergoing rigorous mechanical testing following the final installation of passenger cabins earlier this month.

The Golden Reel represents just one of the stunning world-class non-gaming entertainment offerings to thrill visitors at Studio City, which is set to open later this year. The new integrated leisure destination resort will deliver non-stop entertainment including an action-packed "flying theater" motion ride, Batman Dark Flight; a 40,000-square-foot family entertainment center, Warner Bros. Fun Zone, featuring world-renowned characters from Warner Bros.' DC Comics, Hanna-Barbera Productions and Looney-Tunes entertainment franchises; The House of Magic, featuring an



incredible live magical experience showcasing the world's greatest magicians; Pacha Macau, bringing Ibiza-style nightlife to Macau for the very first time; and a 5,000-seat multi-purpose entertainment center, Studio City Event Center, hosting exciting live concerts, theatrical and top sports offerings in addition to award shows and other special showcase events.

Electrifying entertainment will be combined with an exciting array of accommodation, regional and international dining experiences and designer brand shopping in the 'immersive' retail entertainment environment at The Boulevard at Studio City.

Mr. Lawrence Ho, Co-Chairman and Chief Executive Officer of Melco Crown Entertainment said, "World-class entertainment experiences are the key feature of our leisure destination offerings at Studio City. The Golden Reel is a 'world's first' technological innovation that reinvents the gondola-ride and Ferris wheel experience for our visitors.

"As a new iconic landmark in Macau, the Golden Reel is a totally unique entertainment offering to Asia, and indeed the world, and we continue to deliver on our commitment to expanding the non-gaming leisure and entertainment offerings available in Macau, as a continuing strategy in supporting its evolution into a highly-diversified and world-leading leisure and tourism destination."

Studio City is located on Cotai, Macau, close to the Lotus Bridge immigration point which connects with Hengqin Island, and a future station-point for the Macau Light Rapid Transit. This Hollywood-themed studio-concept resort is set to become Asia's New Entertainment Capital.
